



Dear Parent / Guardian

Street Sense pedestrian training is aimed at years 2 & 3 and is going to happen at your school for 5 consecutive weeks involving training children at the roadside in groups of two under close supervision of a trained adult volunteer.

It is essential that we have a number of willing volunteers for 3 weeks of the training as without the help of volunteers the training cannot take place. I am currently recruiting much-needed volunteers, could you spare a Monday **afternoon on the 18th of Jan, 25th of Jan and the 1st of Feb** between the times of **1 - 3pm**, for a maximum of 3 weeks for 2 hours on each occasion in order to help teach children vital road safety skills that could save their life. We will require you to attend a **10 minute chat** before the start of each lesson for the road safety team to explain what you will be required to do in order for you to conduct the pedestrian training (Maximum 2 hours required on each of the 3 occasions).

Training will take place on the dates of the **11th Jan, 18th Jan, 25th of Jan, 1st of Feb and the 8th of Feb** a consent forms will need to be handed back by the last day of the week ending before training commences. All children will be wearing high visibility clothing whilst out training – it is strongly advised that children bring coats as training will take place in all normal weather conditions e.g. a rainy day. Please note that we will be **unable to train your child without a consent form** being returned and signed.

Consent Form 1: is for you to give permission for your child to take part in the on road pedestrian training scheme.

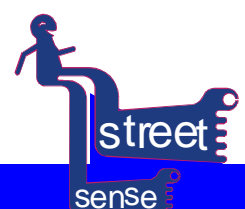
Volunteer Form 2: Volunteer Details: We need a ratio of 1 volunteer to 2 children so your help is essential – please try and commit some time or have a member of the family willing to commit some time to help train the children for 3 weeks. **Training cannot take place unless we have enough volunteers.** Volunteers must be CRB cleared or vouched for by the school – please contact the school secretary.

If you want to join us as a parent/guardian helper and can spare up to 2 hours a week for 3 consecutive weeks or would like further information on the scheme, we would be delighted to hear from you. Please complete the attached volunteer details section and return it to your child's class teacher. Full training will be given and more details will be made available to you in the near future.
