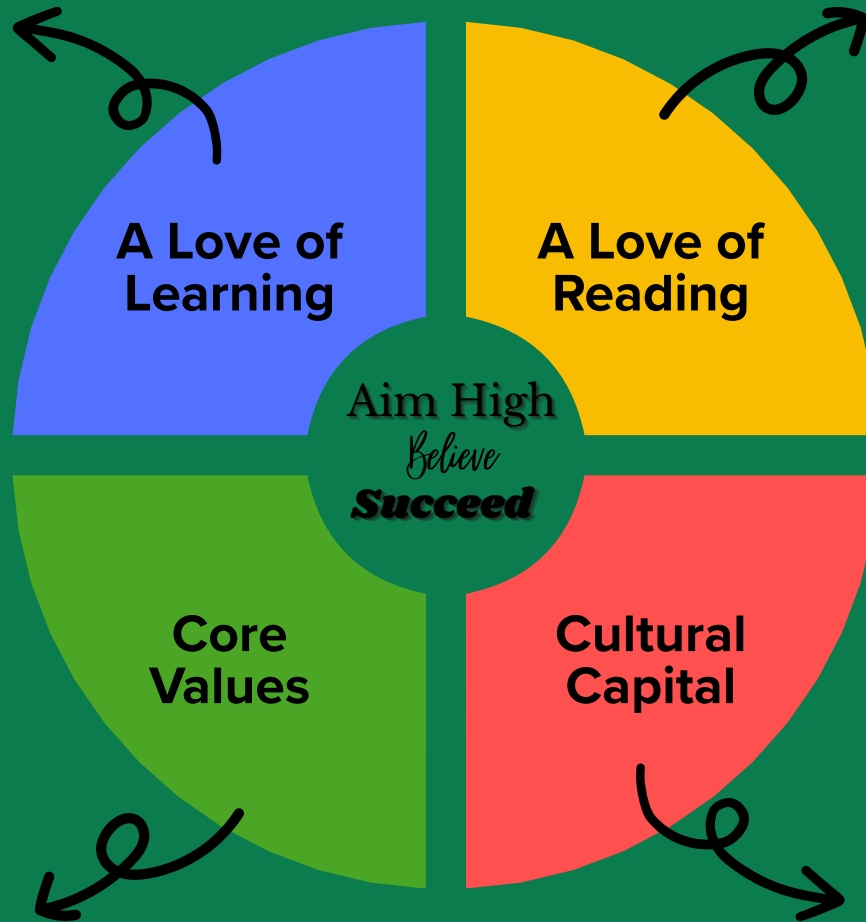


Our Curriculum Drivers
