School wishlist

- Coaches to theatre trips
- Christmas shows - £1500
- Adventure Playground was shut at the start of term for health and safety reasons. Black guttering has been purchased to solve some problems. Two slides are also broken and replacing them is difficult due to their length and position. School spoke to Big Wood about building a platform to support changes and make the space safer. This is £5000 to build. A further £750 is needed for a net. The school would also like 14m of seating in

the forest school area and this is around £520. All together, with a few additional costs, it will come to around £7,500 to complete.

- Books for the Library - new non-fiction books
- The school would like to extend the sand pit as it is not large enough to accommodate all the children who would like to use it. Currently it is a strange shape and small. School we need lots of sand for this too.
- Gardening shed and tools that children can access whether gardening club is happening or not.
- School could do a 'wish-list' for items they need - this could be put on the PTA webpage when it is up and running.

In the newsletter we could do a *'this month we need ...'* Then parents can either donate by clicking a button/scanning a QR code or donating something of relevance - IM to chat to explore this option.
